The Ethnic Student Ministerial Scholarship Fund awards grants to ministerial students for the payment of tuition costs and textbooks.

The benefits of this fund are available to applicants who qualify for aid and who are attending a Nazarene educational institution. It is administered through the Mission Strategy USA/Canada office at Nazarene Headquarters, and applications are made by the Financial Aid office of the respective institutions.
